Procedures for Requesting a Golf Cart in KWGA Golf Competitions when Golf Carts are not Permitted

Competitors or caddies who seek permission to use a motorized golf cart during a KWGA golf competition due to a claimed permanent disability under the Americans with Disabilities Act* are required to submit the following documentation concurrent with submission of KWGA entry forms/documents:

- Written documentation from a medical doctor that sets forth the exact nature of the disability/disabilities and how that disability prevents the competitor or caddie from walking during a stipulated round of golf; and
- Written request for a golf cart.

The KWGA will evaluate each request to use a cart in a KWGA-sanctioned golf competition in accordance with the Americans with Disabilities Act. All medical documentation and golf cart requests will be retained on file for the current golf season. Such requests must be submitted annually.

A neutral (non-family/non-friend) cart driver must be secured where the competitor is a junior golfer playing in a junior golf event in which junior competitors are not allowed to communicate with family or friends during the stipulated round.

Golf cart rental will be at the expense of the player.

Requests will not be granted for “temporary” injuries or impairments that do not qualify as a “disability” under the Americans with Disabilities Act.

* Disability protected by the Americans with Disabilities Act is “a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more of the major life activities of such individual.”
